#### Bus

Take airport bus 6011 from Incheon International Airport bus stop 12A to the Samseongyo, Hansung University bus stop. Transfer to blue bus 273 and get off at the Kyung Hee University bus stop.

#### Subway

Take the airport line subway towards Seoul Station in front of Incheon International Airport exit 3.

Transfer to subway line 1 to Hoegi Station. Take mini bus 01 to Kyung Hee University from exit 1.

#### Lodging near KHU

#### 1. Hoegi Coop Residence

7, Hoegi-ro 28-gil, Dongdaemun-gu, Seoul

Note: You can walk from this residence to KHU. It's near the subway station.

#### 2. Holiday Inn Seongbuk Seoul
