

FOREWORD

The proceedings here to be presented constitute a collection of papers prepared and read before the Second Japanese-Korean Workshop on Formal Grammar which was held in Kyoto in February 1983, under the auspices of the Logico-Linguistic Society of Japan. (The first workshop took place in Seoul in January 1982.)

As in the case of the first one the workshop was organized in order to furnish an occasion for presenting current researches and promoting a friendly co-operation amongst the Korean and Japanese linguists working in the field of logical grammar or Montague grammar, as it is sometimes called.

It is sincerely hoped that the papers collected here will be of a great use in making more readily accessible the scholarly works in this and the related fields going on both in Japan and Korea to wider circles of linguists and grammarians in the world.
